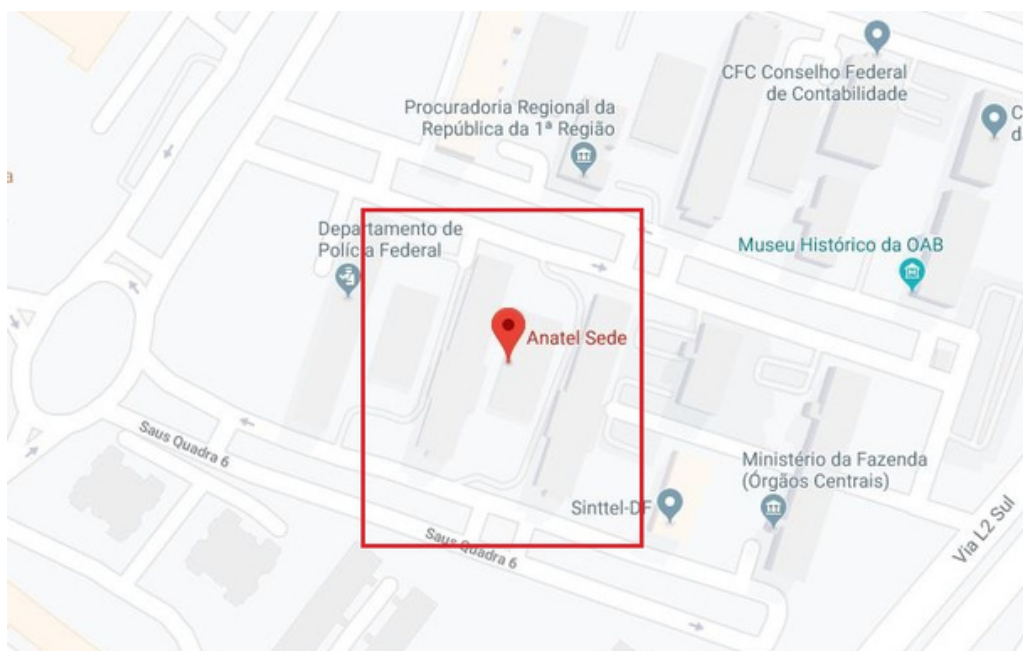

VACCINATION

The Health Ministry of Brazil recommends that foreign visitors update their vaccination status before arriving to Brazil, according to the calendar guidelines of your country of origin or residency, particularly regarding the vaccines against yellow fever, polio, measles, rubella, diphtheria and tetanus.

The **yellow fever vaccine** should be taken by travelers at least ten days before their trip, which is the time required for the vaccine to come into effect and to provide protection against the infection.

INSURANCE

At the unlikely case of illness or injury, **the delegates are held responsible for the costs of the medical assistance**. Delegates should consider the possibility to have travel insurance before coming to Brazil and make sure that the coverage holds throughout your stay in the country.

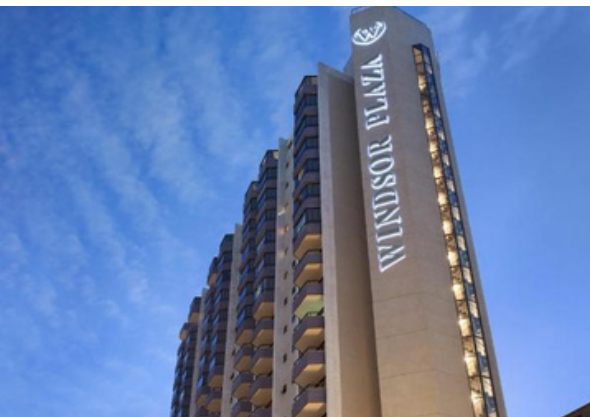

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

CURRENCY & BANKING

Payments are accepted only in reais, the local currency. For reference, the exchange rate is approximately US\$ 1.00 = R\$ 5.00

International credit cards (Visa, MasterCard, American Express and Diners Club) are generally accepted at hotels, department stores and restaurants.

Bank agencies are open from 11 am to 4 pm during weekdays only. Foreign currencies and travel checks can be exchanged for reais in select bank agencies (Banco do Brasil, Banco Central, Banco de Boston and Citibank). It is recommended that you use Banco do Brasil to withdraw cash or to perform exchange in its agencies placed at the international airports of Rio de Janeiro, São Paulo or Brasília.



TIME ZONE

The Brasília standard time is UTC-3.

LANGUAGE

The primary language in Brazil is Portuguese.

CLIMATE

The temperature in Brasilia during the month of February is between 77-83°F | 25-28°C

ELECTRICITY SUPPLIES

Electricity in Brazil is supplied in alternating current (AC) at 220 V
It is recommended that delegates bring a universal adaptor.

Rideshare apps such as **Uber** are safe and can be used

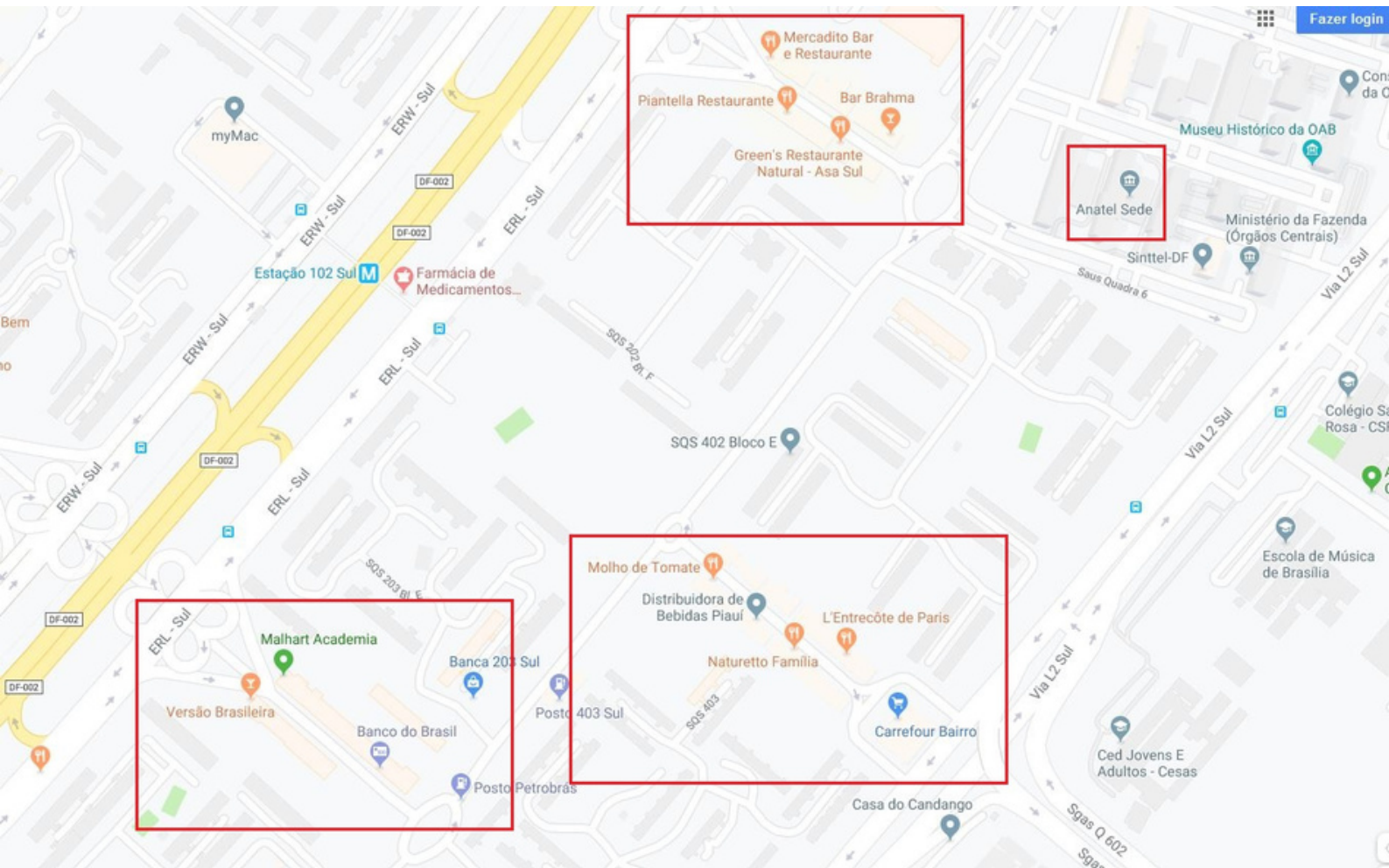
THE CLOSEST AIRPORT TO ANATEL IS A 15MIN DRIVE AWAY:

10-minute ride by taxi (US\$5.00)

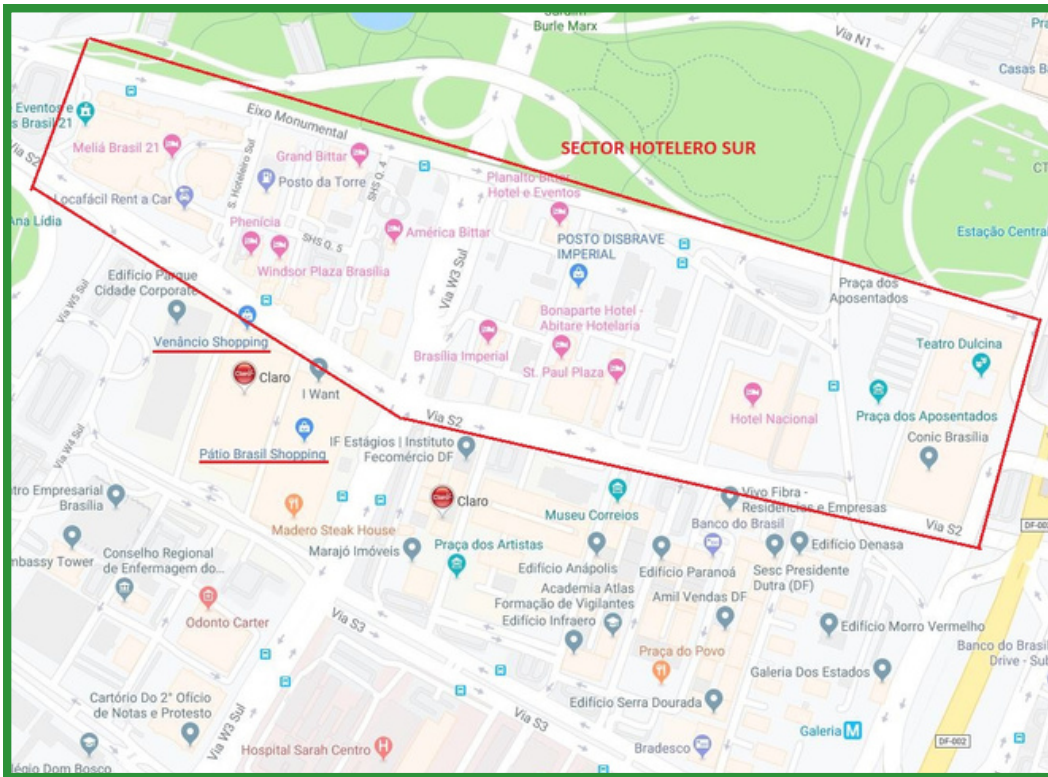
SERVICES NEAR THE VENUE

For the convenience of delegates, there are various restaurants, stores and markets close to ANATEL.

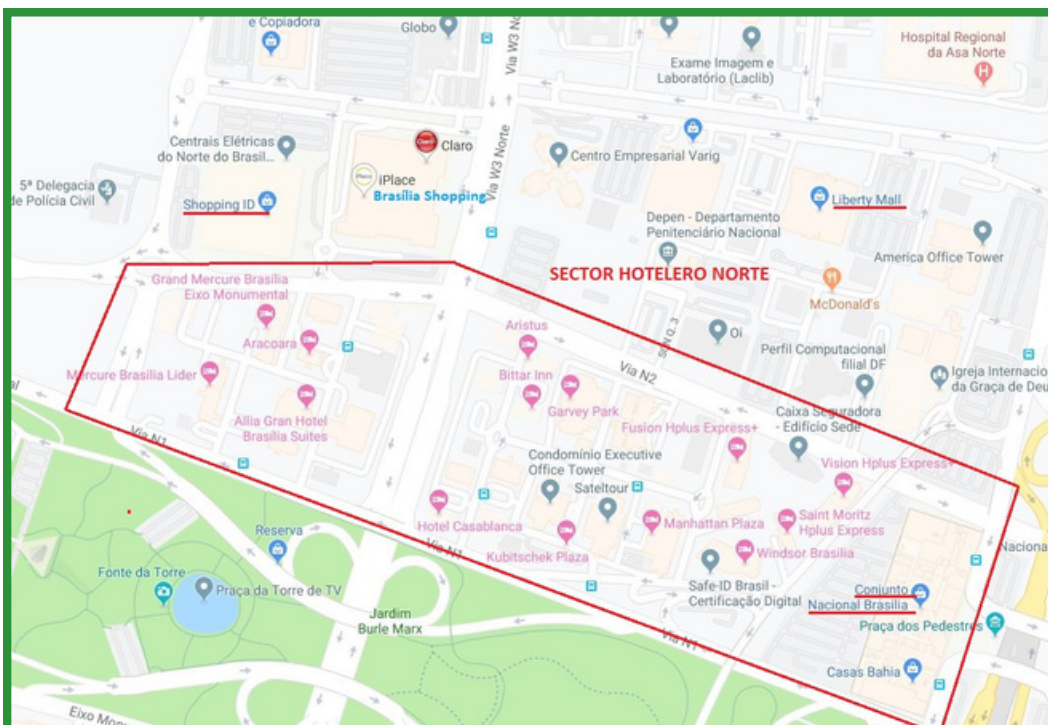


As seen above, everything is relatively close and within walking distance.

TOURISTIC INFORMATION

Brasília, the capital of Brazil is a city that looks surprisingly modern and which was built (starting in 1957) in a previously uninhabited location, to replace the busy Rio de Janeiro as the national capital.

Along the fuselage, where the main axis of the city is located, the main offices of the government are located, the Metropolitan Cathedral, the National Library, the National Theater (currently under renovations) and the Museum of the Republic; along the wings, North and South, the residential buildings and embassies are located. At the nose of the airplane, the Three Powers Plaza is located. At its sides, there are the Planalto Palace, the National Congress and the Supreme Federal Court buildings. This area, from the Metropolitan Cathedral all the way to the Three Powers Plaza is named Ministries Esplanade.

The main buildings in Brasília were designed by the renowned Brazilian architect Oscar Niemeyer.

Nearby the Hotel Sectors, there is the TV Tower, one of the most recognizable landmarks of the city. In front of it, there is also the illuminated water fountain, with a light show that goes live at nighttime.

There is also the Sarah Kubtischek Park, one of the largest in the world and the largest in South America.
