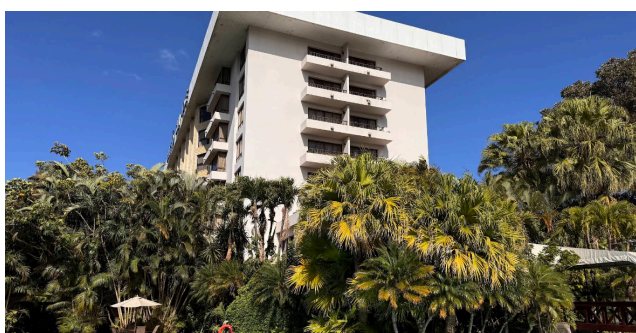
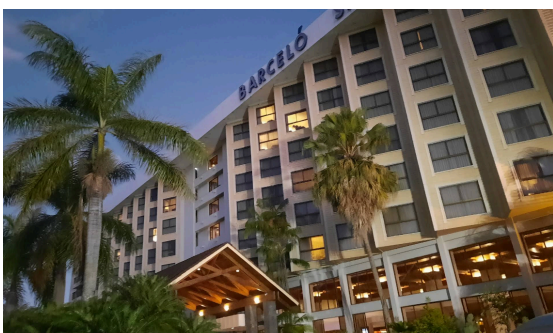

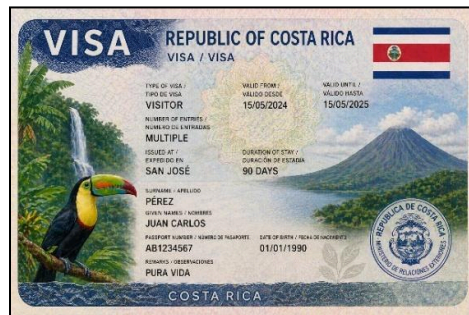

	Coins: https://www.bccr.fi.cr/billetes-y-monedas/Monedas International credit cards (Visa, MasterCard and American Express) are generally accepted in hotels, department stores and restaurants.
Electric current	Electricity in Costa Rica is supplied in alternating current (AC) at 110-120 V. It is recommended that participants bring a universal adapter. 
Time Zone	Costa Rica's standard time is GMT-6 .
Language	The main language in Costa Rica is Spanish , but most of the population speaks English.
Climate	The temperature in San José, Costa Rica, during the month of September ranges between 15 °C and 25 °C. September is the rainy season, so bring your raincoat and umbrella. The typical weather is sunny mornings followed by rain in the afternoon.
