1. Summary of PRIDA project

The PRIDA (Policy and Regulation Initiative for Digital Africa) aims to foster universally accessible, affordable and effective wireless broadband across the continent to unlock future benefits for the cross-cutting use of ICTs.

The International Telecommunication Union (ITU), as per the agreement signed with the European Union, is responsible for radio spectrum management component and is setting up the related Management Team and Technical Committee (TechCom). The primary role of the TechCom is to act as a source of technical expertise to assist and advise ITU on technical matters pertaining to the implementation of the project's activities addressing Spectrum issues

To assist and contribute to solve the problems and improve spectrum efficiency in developing countries, workshops will be organized on effective spectrum management which includes experts' presentations and discussions among the participants ,sharing knowledge on spectrum management administration and experiences calculation method and tools. Through this first workshop, not only the experts in the operation of SMS4DC software and of HCM4A or in charge of Cross Border frequency, but also officials responsible for spectrum management in developing countries can participate. This will also be an opportunity for promoting and sharing the advantages of software assisted spectrum management tools and the know-how of effective spectrum management within the constraints of limited technical and human resource.
