1. Online registration relating to the 'Standards: Your innovation bridge' European Conference

The web page http://www.eu-ems.com/summary.asp?event_id=235&page_id=2027 offers you an online electronic registration for the above-mentioned event. While registering, your personal data will be collected and further processed for the purposes detailed hereafter under point 2. The relevant processing operations and the event are under the responsibility of the European Committee for Standardization (CEN), acting as the organising party.

While collecting and further processing personal data, CEN will obey by the 'Law on the protection of privacy in relation to the processing of personal data'¹ applicable in Belgium with regard to the processing of personal data by any natural or legal person, public authority, agency or any other body.

2. What personal information do we collect, for what purpose and through which technical means?

Identification Data

The personal data collected and further processed will be:

- Data necessary for the organisation and management of the event such as:
 - gender (needed for the right title)
 - name
 - surname
 - profession
 - e-mail address

- mobile phone number, etc.

- Supplementary information for your profile such as resume and personal picture (only for speakers, Chair of Ceremony, Moderators)
- Photographs, interviews and videos of participants and organisers taken during the event

The purpose of the processing of personal data performed in the context of the European Conference 'Standards: Your innovation bridge' is primarily the management /organisation of the event (including e.g. the management of lists of contacts, invitations, distribution of reports, feedback on the event, follow-up actions, information sharing etc.). Interviews, videos and pictures can be also published on the website dedicated to the event on and on social media channels.

3. Technical information

Cookies are not used during the registration process.

Who has access to your information and to whom is it disclosed?

Some of your personal data (gender/first name/last name/personal picture/function/email/organisation/country) will be published in the participants list distributed during the event. If you do not agree with this, please opt-out where required.

We will take pictures during the event, record videos and broadcast the conference live online and post afterwards on YouTube channel. Therefore, some of your personal data (photographs and videos of participants taken during the event) could also be published on the dedicated website of the event and on the CEN, CEN-CENELEC websites as well as social media channels.

No personal data is transmitted to parties, which are outside the recipients and the legal framework mentioned.

4. How do we protect and safeguard your information?

The collected personal data and all information related to the above mentioned meeting is stored on a computer of CEN's external contractor, acting as processor, who has to guarantee the data protection and confidentiality required by the regulation mentioned.

5. How can you verify, modify or delete your information?

In case you want to verify which personal data is stored on your behalf by the responsible controller, have it modified respectively corrected or deleted, please contact the Controller by using the Contact Information below and by explicitly specifying your request.

If you wish to delete your personal information, any trace to be able to contact you will be lost and you will not be able to attend the conference.
